

PROJECT INFORMATION

„Das neue WIR“ 2017/2018



Brief description

The project "Das neue WIR" qualifies 20 people aged 18 - 27 who live in Berlin for project management and intercultural teamwork. In a team the participants test their gained knowledge by developing exciting projects together. With those projects they shape their community in Berlin. When the project is finished, the participants are able to develop, present and successfully implement their own projects. The workshops usually take place on weekends, so participation is possible besides school, university or work. Participation is free of charge. All participants will receive a title certificate as "**Interkulturelle_r Projektmanager_in**" (intercultural project manager).

Target group

The project is aimed at **all young people who live in Berlin, aged between 18 and 27 years**. We are looking for committed people who would like to learn about project management and intercultural team work in intercultural, multilingual teams and who want to design their Berlin through voluntary collaborative projects. You should have time for about 2-3 days per month in the period September 2017 to September 2018.

Content

The participants team up and develop small project ideas and implement them together.

Contents of the seminars and modules are:

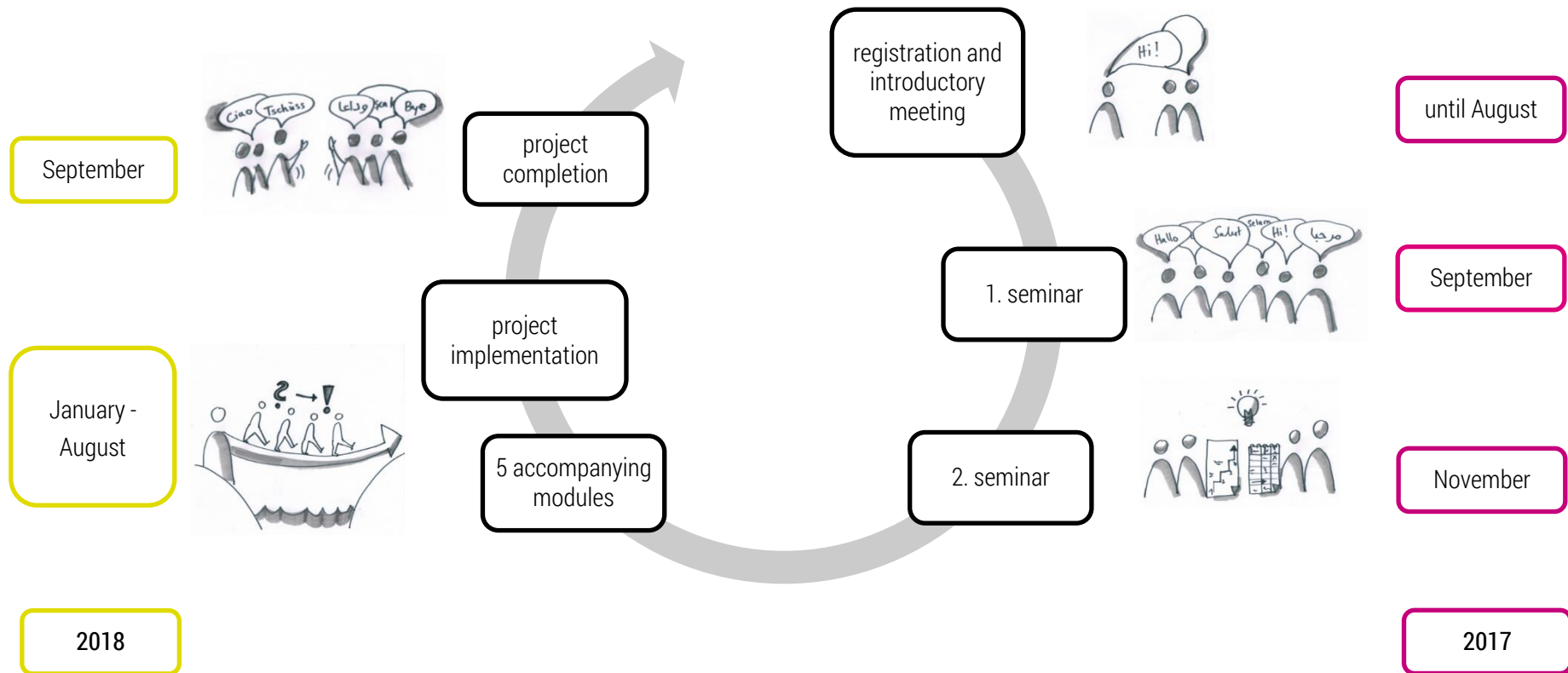
- Project management; instruments for project development and implementation.
- Financing of projects / Fundraising and budgeting
- Dealing with conflicts in teams and in project work
- Presenting, negotiating and moderating
- Intercultural teamwork: Identify strengths and weaknesses of the team, distribute tasks within the team
- Exchange with interesting people from initiatives, associations, administration ministries and the city of Berlin

Support

Two trainers (from the Akademie für Ehrenamtlichkeit Deutschland and the SC Bomani e.V.) support the participants during the entire period of the process in the teams and during the conception and implementation of their project ideas.

The course of the project

The project consists of two introductory weekends followed by monthly accompanying modules. The contents of the modules are developed in consultation with the participants.



Appointments in 2017 und 2018 - Please block the following dates:

1. seminar: Introductory weekend from 01. to 03.09.2017

18:00 h to 15:00 h



This is where the project participants get to know each other. There is an (intercultural) team building, e.g. a climbing parcours is visited. First project ideas are collected.

2. seminar: Formation of the teams from 10. to 12.11.2017

18:00 h to 15:00 h



This is where the teams are formed (about 4 or 5 groups), who will develop and implement a project together. There will be a first input about project management and biography work. The next steps and contents of the workshops, the communication and the allocation of exercises are planned.

3. Accompanying modules on 5 days (1. Saturday in January, February, March, May and August)

The contents of the workshop days and the coaching are coordinated with the participants together as required. Possible content can be:

Content: Project planning, project development, budgeting, application, project promotion, volunteering, interculturalism

Methodical: creative seminar methods, visualization, seminar design, planning games, moderation etc.

4. Project completion 22.09.18



On this day the participants will present their projects and what they have learned during the entire project period: What were "aha" moments? What were highlights and lowlights? How can the project continue in the future? Furthermore, the farewell of the participants from each other and from the project is planned here. The participants receive their certificates and can present their project to a broader audience.

Application requirements

- Completed application sheet ([template online](#))
- Letter of recommendation from an organization, university or person from the personal environment and / or an interview
- Residence in Berlin
- Age: 18 -27 (at the time of submission of the application)
- German language skills up to B2 are an advantage to follow the seminar content. At the beginning, the seminars will take place in German and English and will be translated into other languages as required.
